## New Coach Bursary

The new Coach Bursary scheme started on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011, this funding has been developed to support any Level of Coach to increase the participation of those aged 16+ within Cornwall. Funding will support coaches with 50% of the course fees or maximum of £150 per person and £200 per club.

### Criteria:

1. Applications must be received by the CSP at least one month before the course start date and successful applicants will be informed before their course takes place.
2. You must be registered with **Get Coaching Cornwall** (for more information click - [www.getcoachingcornwall.co.uk](http://www.getcoachingcornwall.co.uk))
3. You must be able to demonstrate a commitment to coaching over 16 years olds and evidence what you deliver once you have achieved your qualification
4. Your application form must be endorsed by your sport's National Governing Body Development Officer – the CSP will do this for applicants
5. If successful, you will receive payment on completion of the course by submitting an invoice to CSP – please note the deadline for all payments is 30<sup>th</sup> April 2012
6. After completing the course, your qualification will need to be uploaded and verified on [www.getcoachingcornwall.uk](http://www.getcoachingcornwall.uk)

### HMRC Coach and Private Tutor Campaign

Coaches and private tutors have until 6 January 2012 to register for the *Tax Catch-up Plan* as part of the HMRC's latest campaign to encourage disclosure of undeclared tax liabilities.

Coaches and tutors who register for the plan will have until 31 March 2012 to let HMRC know about any tax owed for the years up to 5 April 2010, and pay the outstanding amount.

By doing this the terms of payment will be more favourable than those on offer to people who wait for the HMRC to come to them, with reports suggesting that the penalty for those who register will be set at no more than 20 per cent.

- o Communicating with children



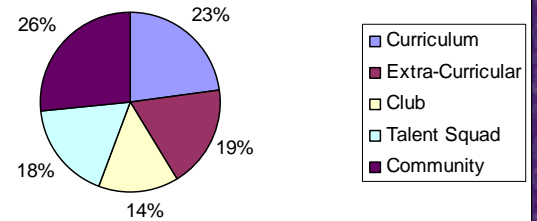

## Coaching by Numbers

It's not always about the numbers but sometimes it's good to see how many young people and adults we have had an impact on. Over the last year, between April 2010 and March 2011, our Coaches have directly Worked with 39,945 young people (35% of young people within Cornwall), 12,116 adults (3% of adults within Cornwall), 21,541 females and 1,297 people with a disability; delivering 6,932 hours.

We also delivered needs lead CPD opportunities for 468 coaches who attended a workshop or course and supported 59 coaches with a coach bursary for either a Level 1 or Level 2 qualification.

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## Coaching Plan

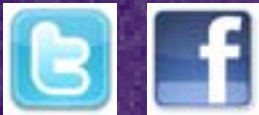

We anticipate that many will continue to give of their time, further increasing sport participation long after the 2012 Games are held in the UK.
