GENERIC AWARD INFORMATION

Boccia Leaders Award a 4 / 4½ hour course with a requirement to deliver 2 hours of Boccia to achieve accreditation. (This is self-certified)

Course aim: To provide individuals involved at community and recreational levels with a basic understanding of the sport.

It is suitable for community workers, leaders and individual players (e.g. those involved in Local Authority Youth Games, individuals and staff of residential homes, sports clubs - Boccia specific and multi-sport, after-school clubs etc.)

Cricket Young Leaders Awards a 6 hour can be run as a independent Bolt On to Sports Leaders UK Awards with a requirement to complete 10 hours voluntary work

Course aim: To help develop generic leadership skills in a cricket context.

It is suitable for students at specialist sports colleges and secondary schools as well as young people who have achieved a leadership award in the community.

Young Netball Organiser Award a 6 hour and can be a stand alone course or as a Bolt On to Sports Leaders UK Awards

Course aim: To enable young leaders to organise and help in out of hours clubs with encouragement to progress to Level 1 Coaching or Umpiring.

Golf Foundation Junior Golf Leaders Workshop a 6 hour workshop designed to provide young leaders with the knowledge of leadership in Golf.

On completion of the workshop should be able to support a PGA professional deliver a coshing session to young people

Netball Youth Umpire Award a 6 hour and can be a stand alone course or as a Bolt On to Sports Leaders UK Awards

Course aim: To gain an understanding of the fundamental skills of umpiring and coaching.

Young Volleyball Leaders Award - This 6 hour course is designed to be used by clubs, schools and youth groups either as a stand alone award or to compliment the Sport Leaders Level 1 Award in Sports Leaders.

Junior Rowing Leaders Award - Up to 12hours can work as a stand alone course or bolted on to Sports Leaders Awards

Course aim: To take this Leadership Award you will have to develop an understanding of Indoor Rowing. Although not essential it would be helpful if you have been personally involved in indoor rowing.

At the end of Award 1, under qualified supervision you should be able to;

- Use ARA resources to deliver indoor rowing sessions
- Develop games / skills related to indoor rowing.

Rowing Leaders will have the opportunity to be involved in Rowing Competitions across the county.

Young Volleyball Leaders Award - Add This 6 hour course is designed to be used by clubs, schools and youth groups either as a stand alone award or to compliment the Sport Leaders Level 1 Award in Sports Leaders.

Volleyball Community Sports Leaders Award - This 12-hour course prepares the Leader to be able to assist in the introduction of volleyball as a recreational game to a group of inexperienced adults or children in a safe, controlled and enjoyable manner.

Course aim: basic concepts, skills and rules are introduced through progressive small-sided versions of the game. The course is not examined and an attendance certificate will be awarded to those who complete the course.
